Story: Only project in the US where Dave Phinney makes wine from a vineyard he owns. Comes in six packs with six different front labels—all the same wine.

Vineyard: Purchased abandanoned farm in 2015 on the western-edge of the Sta. Rita Hills AVA and planted Pinot Noir and Chardonnay in 2018 and 2019. Sandy, silica-rich, diatomaceous earth soils and cool, windy climate, making it a world class grapegrowing region for Burgundian varietals.

Wine: Aromas of black cherry, hibiscus, rose petal, and strawberry. Palate of raspberry, pomegranate, baking spices, amaro and more black cherry. Ripples of acidity and soft texture keep the wine fresh and invitina.

100% Pinot Noir from the Our Lady of Guadalupe Vineyard. A blend of six different clones.

Aged in French Oak for 13 months, 54% New.

Takeaways: Approachable and ready to drink, it is a rich Pinot Noir from cool climate—very balanced with natural acidity.
